











Climate Change is real and its happening right now...Possible scenarios / consequences

> An increase in air temperature in Bulgaria from 2 to 5°C by the end of the century

- ✓ Cold winters will occur less often in the 2020s and will probably disappear by 2080s.
- ✓ More often hot summers and almost every summer is expected to be unusually hot in the 2080s.
- ✓ Winter precipitation will increase by the end of this century but rainfall during the warm half of the year and especially during the summer is expected to decrease.
- > Water resources annual river runoff is likely to decrease during this century.
- ✓ Increase in the frequency of the *hot air waves* combined with increased humidity and *urban air pollution*.
- ✓ Further limitation of water resources, *more forest fires, landslides and floods*.
- ✓ Possible *outbreak of infectious diseases* (including such as malaria, that are not typical for our latitudes).
- > Deforestation
- Change in arable land and crops















Climate Change is real and its happening right now... Impact of on human health and communities

Climate change is projected to double its adverse health effects by 2030. Climate change consequences will be more serious and more pronounced than currently observed. Climate change has a direct (fluctuating temperature, rainfall and extreme phenomena) and indirect (air pollution, quality and quantity of water and food and population migration) impact on human health.

- ✓ The highest relative risk to human health in the future, including Bulgaria, will be floods;
- ✓ Increase in number of diseases caused by contaminated water after flood. Possible outbreaks of infectious diseases (including diseases such as malaria that are not typical of our latitudes).
- ✓ Dissemination of diseases in new areas, areas not typical before;
- ✓ Increased morbidity due to elevated temperatures, humidity or drought. Deaths increase by 2 5% for every degree Celsius, increasing the incidence of new diseases or exacerbating existing diseases.
- ✓ Possible injuries, respiratory, infectious, cardiovascular diseases, etc.











Climate Change is real and its happening right now... Actions /results

- > Strengthened political, legislative and institutional framework;

- Increased capacity to provide humanitarian assistance;

Strategies, policies at international level and Bulgarian legislative, political and institutional framework















Bulgarian Red Cross is a part of the national legal and institutional basis, supports building long-term resilience to climate risks

- ➤ Disaster Protection Act (National Law for disaster and crisis situations);
- ➤ National Strategy and Plan of Action for Climate Change Adaptation;
- ➤ The Disaster Risk Reduction Strategy, the National Disaster Protection Program and the Annual Plan for the implementation of the National Program;
- > Other sectoral laws, strategies, action plans and programs for the implementation of the plans...
- ➤ Well-established civil protection, disaster response system within which there are defined roles and responsibilities under the Rescue System, good cooperation with the EU with regard to civil protection, training and integration with the Bulgarian Red Cross in response to disasters.



Bulgarian Red Cross (BRC) Act (1995). Role and responsibilities of the BRC.

➤In situations of disasters and crises, the BRC is auxiliary and is a part of the National Program and the State National Plan for Protection of Population.

- The BRC is a member of National Consultative Council on Disaster Risk Reduction
- ➤ The BRC, as a part of the International RC Movement, cooperates and coordinates with International Federation of Red Cross/Red Crescent Societies (IFRC), International Committee of Red Cross (ICRC), sister National Societies (NS) and with other external partners.
- ➤ Climate change is addressed at the BRC's Plans

- Focus on the humanitarian aspects of climate change and strive to reduce vulnerability, mobilizing resources, giving priority to the most vulnerable








Strategies, policies of the International Red Cross Red Crescent Movement

IFRC's Strategy 2030

- ✓ Climate change is highlighted as one of the five global challenges faced by the Movement in the next decade.
- ✓ Climate action is first "Area of Focus".
- ✓ IFRC 's Disaster Risk Management Policy highlights "climate-smart" disaster risk reduction.
- ✓ In 2018, the IFRC network reached nearly 52 million people in all regions of the world with climate adaptation and disaster risk reduction projects.
- ✓ Adaptation and the humanitarian impact of climate change, including impacts on health and migration, are one of the priority areas of activity of the Movement for the next 10 years.

Climate change addressed in various outcomes and events at the 2019 Statutory Meetings



33-th International Red Cross Conference Resolution 7 on "Disaster Laws and Policies that "Leave No One Behind" identifying key aspects of domestic law and policy that can be strengthened. Disaster Preparedness and Response Checklist endorsed (DPR Checklist).



Joint pledges - NSs and government commit to work together to implement activities to address the climate crisis.



Side events - Spotlight session on "Addressing the Humanitarian Consequences of the Climate Crisis", sharing experiences with States, exploring ways to cooperate further to jointly address the humanitarian consequences of the climate crisis.

Practical session on climate-smart programming, and a session on predictable financing in a changing climate.

- ✓ Documenting and sharing experience and information.



- ✓ Identification of the specific needs of vulnerable groups in disaster situations;
- ✓ Analysis of assistance networks, expansion of existing ones;
- ✓ Training of volunteers to work with vulnerable groups in disaster situations
- ✓ Preparation of information and training materials for action, tailored to the needs of vulnerable groups;
- ✓ Disasters and crisis practical training (simulation) to test the work of volunteers with representatives of vulnerable groups.









Added value of projects to BRC 's CC related activities and contribution to building community resilience



Project "Centers for Improving Population Preparedness for Flood Response" launched in December 2017, financed by OP "Environment 2014-2020" with contracting authority of the Directorate-General of the Ministry of the Interior in the part "Organization of events for the preparation of the population for response to floods and subsequent crises".

The BRC is a partner and carried out activities for over 100 000 BF - students 3th- 12th grade and various other target groups - elderly, volunteers, media representatives, NGOs, firms, etc .

Added value of projects to BRC's CC related activities and contribution to building community resilience

Aware & Resilient Project

EU project co-funded by the Civil Protection Financial Instrument. Carried out with Red Cross partners in Austria, Bulgaria, France, Latvia and Romania. The main results are:

- Adapting and translating awareness raising activity ("Introduction to Risk Reduction" -IRR) for the population. The <u>trainer's handbook</u> and the <u>leaflet "Self-protection plan for me and my family"</u> are available in Bulgarian, English, German, French, Latvian, Romanian and Russian.
- Translating and adapting a <u>training programme for trainers</u> to enable them to run the "Introduction to Risk Reduction" for the population. Available in Bulgarian, English, German, French, Latvian, Romanian and Russian.
- Augmenting and translating gaming tool 'Worst Case Hero' in all languages: The game Worst Case Hero is available in Bulgarian, German, English, French, Latvian, Romanian and Czech.
- Community-based emergency exercises <u>conducted</u> in each participating country. A <u>guide is available</u> in Bulgarian, English, German, French, Romanian and Latvian.

Safe Schools and Kindergartens Project:

Develop an online platform for safe and well-prepared schools

- > Improving the knowledge and competence of children in primary schools and kindergartens on disaster risk reduction;
- > Capacity development and vocational training for primary and secondary school teachers in terms of disaster risk reduction;
- Increasing the social and environmental responsibility of educational institutions.

Results:

- ✓ Development of a resource catalog and a unified package of training materials;
- ✓ An online platform for disaster risk reduction and first aid for primary schools and kindergartens;
- ✓ On-line training in disaster risk reduction;
- ✓ Training of Red Cross teachers and volunteers as project ambassadors;
- ✓ Advocacy document with general key recommendations and versions for countries with key recommendations.

✓ BRCYouth is a partner of the bTV Media Group's campaign Let's Clean Bulgaria Together, which aims to build public sensitivity on environmental issues and make Bulgaria cleaner and more beautiful in the long run.











Climate Change Adaptation - extreme weather events heatwaves, fires

- ✓ In contact with local authorities to provide support to those in need;
- ✓ **Station Points** to inform the population of the risks associated with high temperatures. Protection guidelines are given, bottled water is provided, blood pressure is measured, first aid is rendered, home visits to isolated and elderly;
- ✓ Mainstreaming CCA into Accompanying measures Advice/Info about extreme weather under the EU FEAD - Food assistance program for 300 000 BF.
- ✓ **Media information campaigns. Social media** advice on the BRC website: what to do in the heat to reduce the risk to health;
- Handbook on Disaster, Emergency and Crisis.




















Climate Change Adaptation - extreme weather events, extreme cold

- ✓ Provides food and other necessary items to homeless people and maintains crisis centers for homeless in some of the regional branches. The first crisis center was created on the idea of the BRC Rousse is the village of Buzan on the road Rousse-Varna. There are three more centers in Slivo pole, Pirgovo and Byala.
- ✓ Provides food, drinks and necessary items to those stranded on the roads and highways;
- ✓ **Media information campaigns** leaflets, etc. Social media advice for general public and tourists in mountains on the BRC website how to avoid risks, how to recognize signs of treats to health and to provide first aid in specific situations.
- ✓ Mountain Rescue holds lectures presenting topics related to safe behavior in the mountain in winter conditions.















Climate Change Adaptation - training for disaster and crisis response - flash floods, fires, etc.

Training, exercises, simulations at national and international level.

- ✓ National Team + National teams for water accidents + Mountain Rescue Team with Rescue dogs/volunteers
- ✓ **28** regional teams/volunteers
- ✓ Youth Rescue teams/volunteers
- ✓ 100 psychologists



















Providing humanitarian assistance to affected people in flash floods and other disaster situations

- Response to floods in (Tzar Kaloyan, Asparuhovo, Mizia, Biser, Kameno). Relief items distribution, cash vouches, wash programs, reconstruction.
- ➤ Public campaigns ensuring transparency. Public councils at the BRC for distribution of donated funds.


